BEAVER DAM LAKE - ADVISORY NOTICE (UPDATE)

Orange County's Department of Public Works, in collaboration with the Office of the County Executive and the Department of Emergency Services met earlier today and are actively monitoring the drainage situation at the Beaver Dam Lake dam spillway.

Orange County continues to work with a number of partner organizations and engineers to assess the situation.

At this time, water is flowing through the relief drains, and engineers are consulting with design specialists to investigate further. Later today, divers may enter the water to further assess the situation and identify the source of the water output.

In accordance with emergency action protocols, a dam advisory condition was issued Monday night. This condition does not indicate an immediate threat, but it calls for ongoing monitoring.
