This community-focused event is being held in collaboration with local healthcare providers and community organizations and will feature free health screenings, food, raffles, prizes, photo booths, a DJ, and a health seminar.

"Sweetheart Screening is a great way for our community to come together, have fun, and take care of our health," said Neuhaus. "We are proud to offer free screenings and resources that can make a real difference in people's lives. I encourage everyone to prioritize their health and make wellness, connection, and community a part of their Valentine's Day."

Free health screenings will include:

- Blood pressure screenings
- Cholesterol screenings
- Vision screenings for children
- Skin cancer screenings
- Breast cancer screenings
 - Clinical breast exams available to the first 25 participants

- Prostate cancer screenings
 - Prostate-specific antigen (PSA) blood test

“The Sweetheart Screening is about meeting people where they are and making preventive care accessible in a welcoming, supportive environment,” said Laurisa Sampson, Director of Health Equity. “By bringing free screenings directly into the community, we help break down barriers to care and allow residents to take simple, important steps toward better health.”

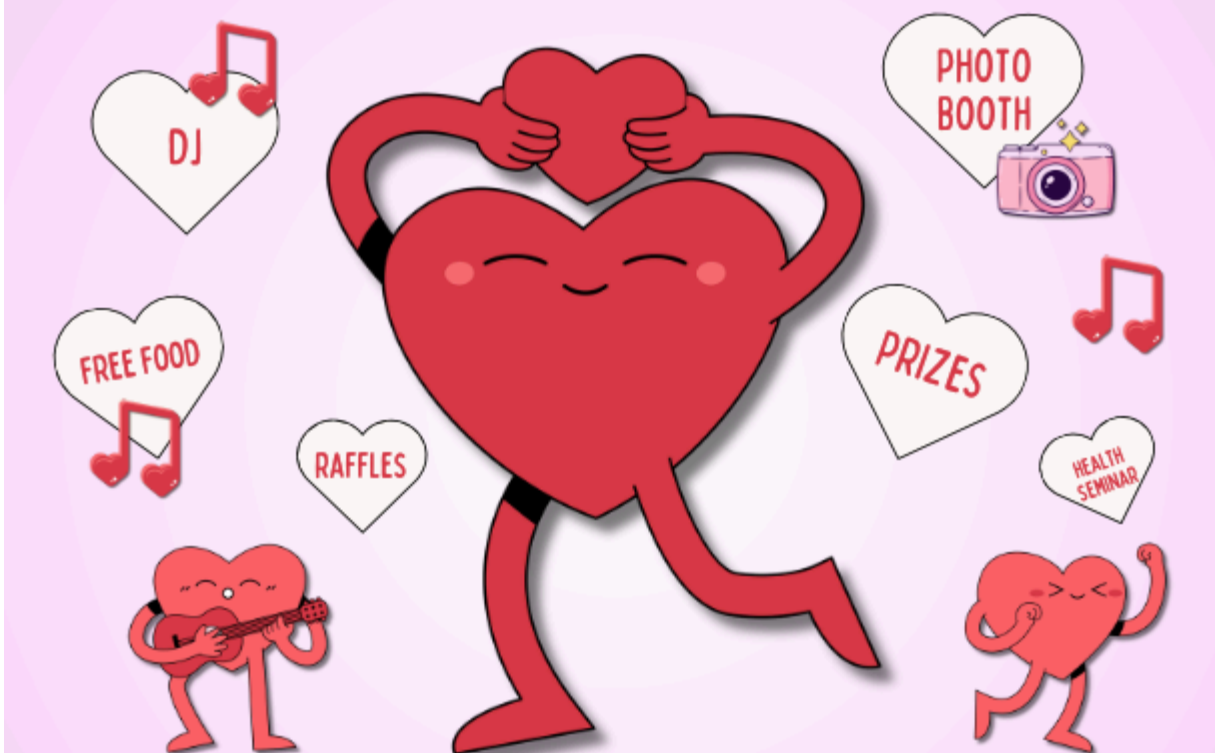
