

**DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE**

BE IT ENACTED by the Chief Executive of the Village of Washingtonville, New York, as follows:

On January 23, 2026, the Governor of the State of New York declared a State disaster emergency for the entire State of New York due to the impending winter storm.

In an effort to control the effects of this winter storm in the Village of Washingtonville, pursuant to the powers vested in me by New York State Executive Law §24, I hereby declare that a State of Emergency exists in the Village of Washingtonville. The State of Emergency shall remain in effect through January 28, 2026, and may be extended at that time.

As Chief Executive of the Village of Washingtonville, I Thomas DeVinko, am issuing this Declaration in order to use the powers granted to me as Chief Executive to issue Emergency Orders as may be necessary to protect the health and wellbeing of the residents of the Village of Washingtonville.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Village of Washingtonville to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
