PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG:

Mayor Bucco led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

MAYOR JOSEPH BUCCO- ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Thursday- June 27, 2019 Washingtonville is holding graduation, we will get message out to all residents in village of what to expect w/traffic & times.

Working w/TILCON, who will be paving streets, Decker, Hayes, & Smith. Looking at middle of August to start paving. Giving DPW enough time to repair catch basins along roads, to camera sewer lines & have O&R do what they need to do.

Past Saturday, Assemblyman Colin Schmidt & I held Anti-vaping forum at High School- good info. on dangers; in planning stage of September of next year.

TRUSTEE RICH CALORE- NEW BUSINESS- WALL BLOCKS FOR VILLAGE:

Went to Fellow Block in New Windsor, lots of different options, this is one that he recommends, kind of block we are talking about, facing front, the standard block, 8 inches high, 18 inches wide, 12 inches deep; big block, 1 block, \$8.12, triple the size, comes out to \$392 per pier- 22 inches wide, 22 inches deep, 60 inches high, you can get different caps.
