VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE, COUNTY OF ORANGE INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2021

A LOCAL LAW ADOPTED PURSUANT TO CANNABIS LAW § 131 OPTING OUT OF LICENSING AND ESTABLISHING ADULT USE CANNABIS RETAIL DISPENSARIES AND ON-SITE CANNABIS CONSUMPTION ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville, County of Orange, State of New York as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to opt the Village of Washingtonville out of hosting adult use cannabis retail dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131, which expressly authorizes cities and villages to opt-out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments to locate and operate within their boundaries.

Section 3. <u>Local Cannabis Retail Dispensaries and Cannabis On-Site Consumption Opt-</u> Out

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville, County of Orange, hereby opts-out of allowing cannabis retail dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption establishments from locating and operating within the boundaries of the Village of Washingtonville.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131, this local law is subject to a permissive referendum and thus may not

be filed with the Secretary of State until the applicable time period has elapsed to file a petition or a referendum has been conducted approving this local law.
