Eengineer Nick Caesar came before the Planning Board on behalf of John Dillion of Orange County Transmissions regarding the application for site plan Mr. Dillon submitted to install two pole buildings on his property at 22 – 24 Hallock Drive.

Engineer Caesar commented that Brookside Auto and Bradley's Auto is located on the property as well as a small hair salon. On the back portion of the lot is where Mr. Dillon proposes to develop two commercial pole barns. The site plans were revised and presented to the Planning Board. There is an existing parking lot in the front and a gravel parking lot in the rear. That parking is for transient vehicles that the two auto body shops are working on. An existing stormwater culvert is shown on the map. The structures will look exactly like Santer Fitness.
