

Local Law #\_\_\_ of 2026

**A LOCAL LAW ADDING SECTION 7-5 TO THE CODE  
OF THE VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville, New York, as follows:

**Section 1.** Amend Chapter 7, “Officers and Employees”, to add a new section 7-5 “Eligibility of Deputy Village Treasurer” which shall read as follows:

“The Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville may appoint as Deputy Village Treasurer any individual who is otherwise qualified to hold public office, provided that such person shall, at the time of his or her appointment and during his or her continuance in office, be a resident of the County of Orange or adjoining counties. This section is enacted pursuant to the authority contained in the Municipal Home Law Rule, which permits the Village to amend or supersede Village law with respect to its own property, affairs or government.”

**Section 2.** This Local Law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
